

## Council Notes-May 30, 2012

- The Election Commission has chosen to change the location where the town votes. Voting will no longer take place in the town gym. In the future, voting will take place at SM Presbyterian Church.
- The council's next work session will be held June 15<sup>th</sup> at 9am. The first reading of the budget will take place at the regular June town council meeting, which has been re-scheduled to Monday, June 18<sup>th</sup> due to this year's TN Municipal League conference in Knoxville. The second reading is scheduled Tuesday, June 25<sup>th</sup> at 10am.
- At its regular May 22<sup>nd</sup> meeting, the Design Review Commission reviewed the Alexian Village's resubmitted building plans in response to questions raised by the DRC at its April 24<sup>th</sup> meeting. The new plans, which show particular sensitivity to the neighborhood, were approved unanimously with only two exceptions: landscape details and railing type.
- The newly renovated town pool is open for the season. Town council members, pool employees, and citizens attended a ribbon cutting ceremony on May 24<sup>th</sup> to mark the occasion. The council congratulates Recreation Director Jarred Thompson who oversaw the renovation project for a job well done!
- The town must now charge a 3.5% user fee for debit cards in accordance with state law.
- Beginning Tuesday, May 29<sup>th</sup> summer hours at the Transfer Station will be in effect until September 28<sup>th</sup>. Hours are 7am to 3:30pm. Be sure and place garbage carts at the curb by 7am.
- First Friday Bulky Item Pickup for June will take place June 1<sup>st</sup>. Call the Town Hall to request service. Mulch will be loaded at the Recycle Center this Saturday, June 2<sup>nd</sup> for \$5 a load.
