- Citizens who object to the Election Commission's decision to change the location where the town votes from the town gym to the Signal Mtn. Presbyterian Church are asked to contact the Election Commission at 423-493-5100 x231 or vote@hamiltontn.gov. The town does not make this decision.
- The council's next work session will be held Friday, June 15th at 9am. The first reading of the budget will take place at the regular June town council meeting, which has been re-scheduled to Monday, June 18th due to this years' TN Municipal League conference in Knoxville. The second reading is scheduled Monday, June 25th at 10am.
- The town must now charge a 3.5% user fee for debit cards in accordance with state law.
- Friday, June 1st was the Ronald McDonald House's "Day of Change". The SM McDonald's, the Chattanooga Times Free Press, and volunteers from the SM cheerleaders, football players, firemen, and the town council worked with Phyllis Lawrence from the Ronald McDonald Foundation to collect donations to the charity.
