

Council Notes-July 4, 2012

- At a special meeting on June 25th, the town council passed the FY 2013 budget on second reading and a final adjustment of the FY 2012 budget to reflect unexpected expenses. The council also approved a resolution authorizing the town manager to enter into an agreement with the International Code Council to assist the town in reviewing construction plans for the new Alexian skilled care facility.
- In addition, Councilmember Annette Allen provided an overview of the Planning Commission's progress as it begins to conclude its work on the new Subdivision Regulations. These regulations are based on conservation design principles, which provide for open space, cost savings, and design flexibility in new subdivisions. The council discussed how the town has and can continue to support local businesses. Remember to shop local and buy local!
- To participate in the Mountain Business Association's 4th of July Parade, begin lining up at 9 am: cars on Signal Point Road, walkers and bikers in front of the Alexian Village, and floats on Ohio. The parade begins at 10am. A map of parking and closed streets along the parade route and for the fireworks is available on the town website. After the parade, visit the Lions' Club Annual BBQ at the SMGCC. Fireworks at the golf course will begin at dark.
- Town offices, the Recycle Center and the Transfer Station will be closed today. Garbage pickup is re-scheduled for Friday July 6th.
- Join the Chattanooga Lookouts at the AT&T Field to celebrate Signal Mountain Night on July 11th at 7:15. Mayor Bill Lusk will throw out the first pitch!
- The Planning Commission meeting is rescheduled from July 5th to Thursday, July 12th.
