- At its monthly work session on Sept. 5th at 9:00, the council will hear an update on the sewer moratorium and will discuss upcoming transportation projects; proposed zoning changes relating to height restrictions in high density residential districts and subdivision entrance structures; proposed Municipal Tree Care and Maintenance Guidelines; the need for an administrative hearing officer; a proposal to restore the Christmas Train; a proposal to install directional signage to the MACC; the installation and policing of crosswalks; an extension to the Disc Golf Course; and, the status of the Health Education and Housing Board.
- At its regular meeting on August 28th, the Design Review Commission approved signage for Siren's Steaks and Seafood and discussed the problem of subdivision entrance features erected on town rights-of-way.
