

## Council Notes-September 19, 2012

- Lend support to the town's opposition to TN American Water Company's request from the TN Regulatory Authority for an increase in water rates for the third time in three years. Come to the Public Comment Hearing at the Hamilton County Courthouse this Thursday, Sept. 20<sup>th</sup> from 4-7pm. Go to the town website and click "TAWC Fact Sheet" for details.
- At its regular Sept. 10<sup>th</sup> meeting, the council appointed Kit Dulin to the MACC Board; authorized the town manager to sign a contract with Southern Flooring to lay a new floor in the Paul Mathis Gym for \$52,748; requested the Planning Commission provide a recommendation to amend the Zoning Ordinance to make maximum building height in high density residential zones consistent with that of all other zones in the town; and, adopted a Municipal Landscape Policy that contains guidelines for the planting and maintenance of trees and shrubs on municipal property.
- Mayor Bill Lusk, Vice Mayor Susan Robertson and Town Manager Honna Rogers attended the Alexian Village Health and Rehabilitation Center Groundbreaking Event on Sept. 13<sup>th</sup>. Construction on its new \$32 million facility is ready to begin.
- Residents and builders are encouraged to stop by the Town Hall to review the town's new Landscape Policy, which contains easy to read Tree City USA guidelines with instructions for planting and caring for trees as well as Best Management Practices for developers and builders on how to protect trees during land disturbance.
- The regular town council meeting for the month of Oct. has been rescheduled to Monday, Oct. 1<sup>st</sup>
