- At its October 1st regular meeting, the town council, acting as the Beer Board, approved Pruett's request for a special marketing event in its parking lot on Saturday, October 27th. A "Tasting" of several locally brewed beers in one-ounce pours will be offered to those 21 years of age and over in possession of a punch card for up to one taste per beer.
- The council passed five resolutions: a memorial resolution honoring the remarkable Martha Swasey and recognizing the Signal School of Physical Education as her legacy to the town; resolutions authorizing the Town Manager to execute the documents necessary for the purchase of fire hydrants, fire hose, fire hose nozzles, and fire hose appliances; and, a resolution adopting the Hamilton County Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan to submit to the Federal Emergency Management Agency.
- Correction: The closure of the Town Gym has been delayed. The gym will remain open until October 15th when the installation of the new floor will begin.
