- At its recent meeting, the Planning Commission heard a request from the town council asking for a recommendation to amend the Zoning Ordinance to achieve consistency in maximum height restrictions in all 12 zoning districts. The council also requested that the location of subdivision entrance features be designated and recorded on subdivision plats to be located out of town rights-of-way, sight triangles, and required setbacks. Both the recommendation and the request were approved. In other business, the Commission voted to accept a calculation to determine yield in conservation subdivisions.
- SMMHS students will volunteer to work with the Tree Board on its service day, Friday, October 26th. Middle school students will mulch trees on the SMMHS campus and high school students will remove invasive species in Memorial Park.
