

Council Notes-December 26, 2012

- At its regular monthly meeting, rescheduled to December 18th because of the holidays, the Design Review Commission approved signage for new businesses, Yessick's on Signal Mountain and El Metate Mexican Restaurant. The Commission decided unanimously to establish a staff review process for signage. Beginning in January, the Commission will undertake the review and update of the Town's 1995 Design Principles and Standards.
- The Planning Commission has rescheduled its regular January 3rd meeting to January 10th at 6pm. Jack Kruesi of High Acres, Inc., has requested that 124 acres on Shackleford Ridge Road, currently zoned Residential Estate, be rezoned Low Density Residential. The Commission will begin the review of Mr. Kruesi's preliminary plat, previously reviewed by the Regional Planning Agency, detailing plans to build a Planned Unit Development containing 199 housing units with an on-site waste treatment plant.
- The Council's first work session of 2013 is scheduled for January 7th at 10am. Currently on the agenda are new employee introductions; a discussion of bee hive location; a request to rescind a ban on rock climbing in the Town; adopting New Street Criteria; board appointments and reappointments, including a new Tree Board liaison; and, potential remedies to the wooly adelgid, now threatening local hemlock trees.
- The Library will close at 5pm on Monday, December 31st, New Year's Eve. The Town offices, Library, Transfer Station and Recycle Center will be closed on Tuesday, January 1st, New Year's Day. Tuesday's garbage will be collected on Wednesday, January 2nd.
- Garbage pickup in the newly annexed areas including Fox Run and Windtree is scheduled for every Friday beginning January 4th.
