- The Planning Commission's next meeting will occur on Thursday, January 10th at 6pm. The Commission will review a request by Jack Kruesi of High Acres, Inc. to rezone 124 acres on Shackelford Ridge Road, currently zoned Residential Estate, to Low Density Residential. The Commission will also begin the review of Mr. Kruesi's preliminary plat, which details plans to build a Planned Unit Development containing 199 housing units with an on-site waste treatment plant.
- The Council's next regular meeting is on Monday, January 14th, at 6:30pm. Tentatively scheduled are a presentation of TDOT's Report on Hwy 127 and potential fixes; the adoption of Criteria for New Streets; resolutions appointing board members, authorizing a contract for an architect for the new public works facility, and designating March 1st as Arbor Day; and, ordinances pertaining to pedestrian crosswalk safety, building heights in PUD's, and an administrative hearing officer appointment on second reading.
- The TN Department of Environment and Conservation has awarded the Signal Mountain Water Department, under the direction of Department Head William Sanders, a score of 100% on its annual water survey.
- Christmas trees will be collected at the curb for recycling beginning Wednesday, January 9th. Please remove decorations, lights, tree stands, and bags. Christmas tree mulch will be available at the Recycle Center soon.
