

## Council Notes-February 20, 2013

- At its regular meeting on February 11<sup>th</sup>, the Council authorized the town manager to enter into a contract with Meeks Construction, LLC, for a water bore to establish a connection with WRUD; appointed Joshua Rogers to the Parks Board and Susan Robertson to the Planning Commission; authorized the town manager to accept an engineering contract with CTI Engineering Company, Inc., for the resurfacing of James Boulevard between Mississippi and the Alexian Village; discussed a recent opinion from MTAS indicating that the Town should not allow rock climbing on public lands due to a lack of management resources and liability concerns; and, on second reading, adopted an ordinance allowing rock climbing on private property.
- The Planning Commission will hold a workshop meeting, Wednesday, February 20<sup>th</sup> at 6pm to discuss a potential revision of regulations in Planned Unit Developments and other zoning changes.

- Thursday, February 28<sup>th</sup>, at 7pm. Emily Parrish of the Land Trust for TN will give a presentation explaining the nature of conservation easements, provide examples of existing easements throughout the state, and answer questions regarding possible easements on certain town parklands.
- The Council has requested that the town manager prepare a resolution for its March regular meeting should the Council decide to move forward with a plan to secure conservation easements in the town.
- The Planning Commission will hold a hearing on Tuesday, March 12<sup>th</sup> for the public review of the new Subdivision Regulations.
- On Saturday, March 2<sup>nd</sup>, free oak and hybrid chestnut tree saplings will be distributed at the Recycle Center from 10am-12:30pm.
