- At its regular meeting on Monday, April 8 at 6:30pm, the council intends to hold a public hearing on zoning Fox Run and Windtree Subdivisions and certain adjacent properties; resolve to thank Frank Preston for his service on the Personnel Committee; award bids for an equipment trailer and paving; authorize the Town Manager to sign a recycling management contract with Orange Grove; and adopt a Planned Unit Development Ordinance and zoning for Windtree and Fox Run and adjacent properties Low Density Residential on second reading.
- The Planning Commission will meet on Thursday, April 4 at 6pm to vote on the proposed new Subdivision Regulations.
- Residents are invited to participate on Wednesday, April 10 from 5-8pm at the Chattanooga Downtown Library in an “input incubator” about Thrive 2055, a 16-county, tri-state growth initiative for our region. Take a 3-D aerial tour of the region, talk to local leaders, vote on ideas generated through peer-to-peer discussions, and learn about Thrive 2055 and the forces and trends shaping our future. Get involved in the Thrive 2055 project and its goal to create a 40-year plan for 16 counties in TN, GA, and AL. The event is free.
