

## Council Notes-May 1, 2013

- At its April 22<sup>nd</sup> work session, the Council heard a preliminary presentation from Greg Wilson of CTI Engineering suggesting various options for re-surfacing James Blvd. between Mississippi and Alexian Village. The Council will hold a public input meeting the first week of June to discuss options and costs. The work will begin after the conclusion of the Alexian building project.
- In addition, the Council resolved to enter into a contract allowing for a \$500 fee increase with town auditors Johnson, Murphy and Wright; discussed a proposed ordinance to amend the hours for alcohol package sales, a donation to the Lion's Club for the 4<sup>th</sup> July festivities; and hiring a delinquent collector.
- At its regular meeting on May 13<sup>th</sup>, the Council is tentatively scheduled to honor the winners of the Arbor Day poster contest; award a bid for pavement striping; authorize the purchase of a stormwater vehicle; adopt an OSHA policy; review a possible recommendation by the Planning Commission to approve an Outline Plan for Wild Ridge at Fox Run; and vote on first reading to amend the Alcoholic Beverages and Sign Regulation ordinances.
- The Council is forming a committee to work with the Land Trust of TN to draft conservation agreements for certain parklands in the Town. To apply, submit an application (available for download on the Town website) at the Town Hall.
