

Council Notes-May 8, 2013

- The Council began its preliminary review of the FY 2013-14 budget at its work session on Tuesday, April 29. The budget will not be finalized until the Council receives a final quote on employee health insurance costs. However, there will be no tax increase.
- At its meeting on May 2nd, the Planning Commission agreed to grant Jim O'Kelley a preliminary plat extension for Conner Creek subdivision; approved an Outline Plan submitted Jack Kruesi for Wild Ridge at Fox Run; heard a request from Dr. Bob Spaulding regarding setbacks in Residential Estate zones; and, discussed development ideas with Frank Groves that may be filed as an application in the future.
- At its meeting on May 13th, the Council is scheduled to honor the winners of the Arbor Day poster contest; select to offer employment to a candidate from among the three finalists who have applied for the position of town manager; award a bid for pavement striping; authorize the purchase of a stormwater vehicle; review and consider a recommendation by the Planning Commission to approve an Outline Plan for Wild Ridge at Fox Run; vote on first reading to amend the Alcoholic Beverages and the Sign Regulation ordinances.
- The swimming pool will open May 25th. Beat the rush! Pool passes are available at the Town Hall. Also, sign up for summer camp, swimming lessons and pick-up basketball too.
