

## Council Notes-May 15, 2013

- The Town is preparing to pave roads this season as follows: James Boulevard from Timberlinks to Rolling Way; a section of Palisades Drive; the entrance to Carriage Hill; Stonehaven Drive; Hampton Road; Mayer Street; South Street; St. Charles; and Stratford Way from James to Primrose. The work is tentatively scheduled to begin the week of May 20<sup>th</sup>. Traffic delays may be encountered during the paving process; however, paving employees will offer guidance through or around the paving zone.
- The Council began its review of the FY 2013-14 budget at its work session on Tuesday, April 29. The budget will not be finalized until the Council receives a final quote on employee health insurance costs. However, there will be no tax increase.
- The swimming pool will open May 25<sup>th</sup>. Purchase season tickets or resident cards at the Town Hall now. Family resident passes are \$200; Adult \$110; Under 12 \$100. Family non-resident passes are \$300; Adult \$160; Under 12 \$150. Daily rates are Adults \$4; Under 12 \$3, Under 5 \$2. Swimming lessons are scheduled for June.
- Three sessions of Summer Day Camp are scheduled as follows: June 3-7; June 10-14, and June 17-21. The cost is \$60 a week for residents and \$75 a week for non-residents.
- Pick-up baseball will be at the Town Gym June 10-28, Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 12-2pm.
