

Council Notes-June 23, 2013

- At its June 21 agenda meeting, the council heard a presentation by Greg Wilson of CTI Engineers, Inc., detailing potential scenarios and associated costs for resurfacing James Boulevard between Mississippi and Alexian Village. A public input meeting will be held in early August before the design process begins. Work on the road will not begin until Alexian concludes construction.
- In other business, Town Manager Chris Dorsey added clarifications to Stormwater and Sanitation expenditures in the FY 2013-14 budget; the council discussed leaf collection and determined that there is no need at present to initiate changes in the collection process; voted on second readings to adopt the proposed FY 2013-14 Budget and the 2012-13 Budget Amendment; and also on second reading, adopted amendments to the Intoxicating Liquors Ordinance and the Sign Regulations.
- Councilmember Dick Gee updated the council on the WWTAs lateral program, which has received a loan to continue its work repairing/replacing service laterals in the town. The work will be performed by contractors rather than independent plumbers and will begin soon.
- Mayor Bill Lusk updated the council on the Transportation Planning Organization's approval to undertake certain improvements in the amount of \$13 million to Hwy 127 up the mountain by 2020.
- The Transfer Station, Town offices, and Recycle Center will be closed for the Independence Day holiday on Thursday, July 4. Thursday garbage collection has been rescheduled for Friday, July 5th.
- Mulch loading at the Recycle Center has been re-scheduled from Saturday, July 5th to Saturday, July 13 due to the 4th of July holiday.
