- A public reception welcoming new Town Manager Chris Dorsey will be held from 5:30-6:30pm on Monday, July 8. Stop by Town Hall and say hello. Refreshments will be served.
- At its July 8 meeting, the council will read resolutions honoring Hayden Hicks; appointing Chris Dorsey as the Mayor's alternate on the Transportation Planning Organization Board; authorizing the purchase of a dump truck; and approving the final payment for the James Boulevard sidewalk.
- On June 27, the Board of Zoning Appeals approved a variance request for a backyard accessory building for Danny Neal at 125 Short Creek. The BZA denied a request for a 23' front setback variance for Dr. Bob Spaulding at 4431 Shackleford Ridge Road.
- Police Chief and Codes Officer, Boyd Veal, organized and conducted a joint meeting of the Planning Commission and the BZA on June 27 for the purpose of establishing a relationship and initiating communication between the two boards, both of which are responsible for understanding and enforcing the town's Zoning Ordinance.
- Line up at 9am to participate in the MBA 4th of July Parade: cars on Signal Point Road, walkers and bikers in front of the Alexian Village, and floats on Ohio. The parade begins at 10am, followed by the Lions Club BBQ at SMGCC. Fireworks at the golf course begin at dark.
