

## Council Notes-August 21, 2013

- At its regular meeting on Monday, August 12, the council approved a resolution authorizing the town manager to take action to ensure compliance with federal guidelines to protect the privacy for those employees insured by the town; approved resolutions authorizing the town manager to apply for TN Municipal League grants to reimburse the town for costs of safety gear and driver safety programs; voted to pass ordinances approving the certified tax rate and amending the Sign Regulations on second readings; and, on first readings, passed a proposed 2013-14 Budget Amendment to adjust the balance in the Vehicle Replacement Plan as well as a revised and updated OSHA policy.
- The tentative agenda for the council's August 26 work session is to approve the Budget Amendment and OSHA policy on second readings; discuss the MACC budget; hear a presentation of the MACC's master building plan; review and discuss zoning amendments, a town attorney evaluation, and the town manager contract.
- A public input meeting on the James Boulevard resurfacing project will be held on Thursday, Aug. 29, at 6pm at the Town Hall. Issues to be considered are road width, rails, and surfacing material.
