

Council Notes-March 5, 2014

- At its regular meeting, the Design Review Commission elected officers for 2014. They are Chairman Karen Rennich, Vice Chairman Ed Garbee, and Secretary Claire Griesinger. In other business, the DRC approved temporary construction signage for Wild Acres at Fox Run and discussed contacting the Southeast TN Development District to assist with the completion of the review and revision of the town's Design Standards.
- At its regular meeting on Thursday, March 6, the Planning Commission will hold a public hearing on proposed amendments clarifying language in the Subdivision Regulations, followed by a vote. The Commission will also consider new definitions and a proposed amendment to clarify the Zoning Ordinance.
- The council's next regular meeting will take place on March 10 at 6:30pm at the Town Hall.
- The Conservation Easement Working Group will seek citizen input on its easement agreement draft at public meetings on Wednesday, March 12, and Thursday, March 13, from 4-8pm. This agreement would protect Rainbow Lake and certain other parklands from future development.
- The Fire Department has received rope rescue training and equipment to prepare them for emergency response for both low and high fall incidents that may occur on local trails.
- The Public Works Department is crossing its fingers, hoping that the weather continues to improve, and thanking citizens for their patience. Leaf collection crews are taking advantage of the daylight hours and the weekends. Area 1 (Old Town) is complete and Area 2 (Hidden Brook, Birnam Wood) is next.
- Citizens are asked to please remember not to park on sidewalks, next to fire hydrants or where "No Parking" signs are posted.
