

Council Notes-April 2, 2014

- The Planning Commission will meet Thursday, April 3 at 6pm to review a revised plat in the Fox Run Subdivision; a temporary cul-de-sac closure on St. Nichols Drive; a proposed ordinance defining “duplex”; and discussions on moderate and high density requirements and certain proposed clarifications in the Zoning Ordinance.
- At its next work session on Friday, April 4 at 10am, the council will meet with representatives from the Tennessee American Water Company to discuss the recent renewal of its contract and representatives from the TN Municipal Bond Fund to discuss the possibility of acquiring a bond rating that could lead to lower loan interest rates. The council will also discuss the Municipal Technical Advisory Service’s recent fire station feasibility study.
- At its regular meeting on Monday, April 14 at 6:30pm, the council will read a resolution authorizing the execution of loan documents with the TN Municipal Bond Fund amounting to \$3M for the construction of a new public works facility, a fire substation on Shackleford Ridge Road, and essential facility repairs. The council will also consider second readings on a 2013-14 budget amendment and an amendment to the Zoning Ordinance relating to accessory structures and swimming pools.
- The next woolly adelgid treatment demonstration will be held at 5131 Old Chestnut Ridge Road on Sunday, April 13th at 3pm. The eggs of the HWA appear on the underside of hemlock branches as a white cottony substance.
