

## Council Notes-May 21, 2014

- At its regular meeting on May 1, the Planning Commission accepted a revised plat in Majestic Oaks, an abandonment of an ROW on Fairview pending the establishment of a utility easement, and discussed additional clarifications in the Zoning Ordinance.
- At its regular May 12 meeting, the council, acting as the Beer Board, approved a request by Siren's Seafood & Steak Market; read resolutions honoring TN State Diving Champion Marissa Roth and former Recycle Center Manager Richard Wald; authorized the town manager to sign a contract for installation of the new purification system at the town pool and to purchase playground equipment; passed a Zoning Amendment defining two-family dwellings on second reading, and on first reading, passed the proposed FY 2014-15 Budget Ordinance and an ordinance purposing the abandonment of a temporary cul-de-sac.
- Tentatively scheduled at its agenda meeting on Friday, May 23, at 10am, the council will hear a presentation of the MACC's revised strategic plan, discuss this year's paving and striping bids; the FY 2014-15 proposed budget that will be considered at the regular June 9 meeting; and the proposed FY 2013-14 Budget Amendment for first reading.
- Registration for the Library's summer reading program begins Tuesday, May 27 at 11am. The program and special events will take place during June and July.
- The town playground camp and MACC string camp have been cancelled due to inadequate enrollment. Season tickets and resident's cards (required to enter the pool) can be purchased at the Town Hall. The pool opens Saturday, May 24.
- Town offices and the Transfer Station will be closed on Memorial Day, Monday, May 26. Trash pickup that day is rescheduled to Tuesday, May 27.
