- As summer approaches, remember that children will be out and about enjoying the community. When pedestrian and bicycle traffic increase, the potential for accidents increases too. A few simple rules may prevent accidents and associated injuries: remember to stop for pedestrians waiting to cross a street at a marked crosswalk; bike riders under 16 years old must wear a helmet; skateboards should not be ridden on roadways; pedestrians walking on a roadway between dusk and dawn must wear reflective clothing; and, finally, remember to slow down--wherever you are going cannot be more important than the safety of a child.
