

## Council Notes-June 4, 2014

- At its May 23 agenda meeting, the council heard a presentation of the MACC Board's revised Strategic Plan; discussed the revisions to policies regarding serving alcohol at the MACC; awarded a contract for water meter replacements, a contract for striping 23 linear miles of street, a contract for paving 2 ½ miles in Hidden Brook, and a portion of the MACC parking lot; approved the proposed FY 2013-14 Budget Amendment on first reading; and discussed the recent MTAS fire study with Fire Chief Eric Mitchell. The study concludes that a fire substation should be built, staffed, and equipped on Shackleford Ridge because of increased development and in accordance with the town's Annexation Plan of Services.
- At its May 27 regular meeting, the Design Review Commission approved signage for FSG Bank with two exceptions and requested Dr. Robert Spaulding to return next month with a revision that complies with the Sign Ordinance. The DRC also reviewed a potential amendment to the Sign Ordinance related to subdivision signage.
- Steve Cox, Special Collections Librarian at the UTC Lupton Library, has recently published the journals of Emma Bell Miles. He will discuss her life and art as well as sign books at the Town Library on Thursday, June 5<sup>th</sup> at 6pm.
