- The Public Works Department expects to begin paving on Brook's Edge Lane, Chamblee Court, Cool Springs Road, Creekshire Drive, Middle Creek Road, Mountain Cove Road, Northfield Road, Fortune's Way and Prentice Lane during the second week of June. Residents on those streets are asked to prepare for the construction by trimming bushes or shrubbery hanging over or within 2-3 feet of the current pavement's edge, but not to put the brush at the curb for pickup until the construction is completed. Also, please place garbage cans at the curb at 7am for pickup. Cans will be emptied before the day's construction work begins.
- During the paving process, paving employees will guide residents through the construction zone. However, vehicles may not be parked on the street; there may be traffic delays; and some tar splatter could occur. There will be no construction on weekends. Call 886-2177 for more information.
