- The following items are tentatively planned for review and discussion at the council's next agenda meeting on Friday, June 27: the Blue Cross/Blue Shield employee health insurance renewal contract for FY 2014-15; a contract with Sun Life Health Insurance for employee dental insurance; a Letter of Understanding with Orange Grove to continue its recycling services; and plans to increase community and citizen use at the MACC.
- Town Manager Boyd Veal has negotiated a contract with the Hamilton County Humane Education Society to provide backup to the Police Department's Animal Control Program. The town will still be responsible for animal control on a day-to-day basis, but the HES will provide assistance in placing homeless pets and dealing with vicious or ill domestic animals. - The Mountain Business Association will host a low-country shrimp boil at Sirens on Tuesday, July 1 at 6:30pm. Everyone is welcome. The cost is \$10 a person. Tickets are available at Sirens, 1st Tennessee Bank or from MBA members.
- Celebrate the 4th of July! Line Up at 9am for the Mountain Business Association's Parade: cars on Signal Point Road, floats on Ohio, and walkers and bikers in front of the Alexian Village. The parade begins at 10am. The parade route will be down James to Texas to the Signal Mountain Golf and Country Club. The Lion's Club BBQ and festivities will follow at Althaus Park. A fireworks display at the golf course will begin at dark.
