

Council Notes-July 9, 2014

- At its June 27 agenda meeting, the council authorized the town manager to enter into agreements with Blue Cross/Blue Shield and Sun Life for employee health and dental insurance for FY 2014-15; a contract with CTI Engineering, Services, Inc. related to the emergency water connection between the town and Walden's Ridge Utility District; a contract with CTI to design and engineer water system modifications for increased fire flow in areas on South Palisades, Brady Point, Laurel, and Mississippi; and a 3-year agreement with Orange Grove Center for recycling services.
- In other discussion, the council agreed to develop a policy with guidelines to serve the MACC's dual function as an arts and community center and voted to authorize the town manager to enter into negotiations to purchase property at 1116 James Boulevard adjacent to the Library to relieve its need for additional working and parking space. The Library now has 5,362 members and is growing.
- The tentative agenda for the council's next regular meeting on July 14 includes two honorary resolutions; the second reading of an ordinance abandoning a ROW on Fairview Street; a first reading of an amendment to the Zoning Ordinance clarifying language relating to "Architectural Projections" and deleting the term "Minimum Building Site"; and a discussion of the "Take Me Home" program designed to ensure the safety of citizens with special needs.
- Public Works asks citizens to solidify leftover latex paint before disposing of it. The town will load mulch on Saturday, July 12 from 9am until 2pm at the Recycle Center.
- The installation of new equipment at the playground adjacent to the town pool is complete. Bring the family and have some fun!
