

RESOLUTION NO. R2007-73

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE GOVERNOR'S HIGHWAY SAFETY OFFICE IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED NINETY-FOUR AND 90/100 DOLLARS (\$100,394.40) WHICH WILL RESULT IN PAYMENT FOR EQUIPMENT, TRAINING AND OVERTIME TO BE PROVIDED AS A HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SAFETY GRANT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITIES TO REDUCE SPEEDING, AGGRESSIVE DRIVING, DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE, AND NON-SEATBELT USAGE FOR CHILDREN AND PASSENGERS WITHIN MOTOR VEHICLES IN THE TOWN.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SIGNAL MOUNTAIN, TENNESSEE, That the Chief of Police be and is hereby authorized to apply for a Governor's Highway Safety Office Grant in the amount of \$100,394.40, plus grantee participation of the Town in the amount of \$33,464.80 for a total project cost of \$133,859.20, which will result in payment for equipment, training, and overtime to be provided as a Highway Safety Grant for law enforcement activities to reduce speeding, aggressive driving, driving under the influence, and non-seatbelt usage for children and passengers within motor vehicles in the Town.
