

RESOLUTION NO. R2008-78

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITIES OF ATHENS, CLEVELAND, CLEVELAND UTILITIES, DAYTON, ETOWAH, SODDY-DAISY, AND THE UNIVERSITY OF TENNESSEE FOR A POSTGRADUATE INTERN IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THREE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED SIXTY SEVEN AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$3,167.00) AND AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS IN CONNECTION WITH THIS AWARD.

WHEREAS, the University of Tennessee has organized an interlocal agreement between the cities of Athens, Cleveland, Cleveland Utilities, Dayton, Etowah, Signal Mountain and Soddy Daisy; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the agreement is for the governmental parties to collectively employ a management intern that will provide valuable services; and

WHEREAS, the Cities collectively will provide the intern a broad exposure to all functional areas of municipal government and individually will provide the intern on-the-job training in each functional area of government and give the intern exposure to several different management styles.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SIGNAL MOUNTAIN, TENNESSEE, That the Town Manager is authorized to enter into an interlocal agreement and to execute any necessary documents in connection with this award.
