

RESOLUTION NO. 2008-7

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF SIGNAL MOUNTAIN, TENNESSEE, AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO PREPARE REQUESTS FOR PROPOSAL ON A FIVE (5) YEARS MAINTENANCE PROGRAM FOR THE TOWN'S FIVE (5) WATER TANKS TO BE PAID FROM THE TOWN'S PUBLIC UTILITY FUND.

WHEREAS, the Town of Signal Mountain operates a public water utility which stores water for the Town's residents within five (5) storage tanks which are located at various locations within the Town; and

WHEREAS, all five (5) tanks require exterior and interior painting and structural repairs which must occur on a regular basis; and

WHEREAS, the Town Manager desires to obtain requests for proposal which could establish uniform maintenance costs for all five (5) Town water tanks on a scheduled program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SIGNAL MOUNTAIN, TENNESSEE, that the Town Manager is authorized to prepare requests for proposal on a five (5) year maintenance program for the Town's five (5) water tanks to be paid from the Town's Public Utility Fund. The Town Manager shall report to the Town Council on the costs of any maintenance program before entering into any five (5) year maintenance program for the Town's water tanks.
