

RESOLUTION NO. R2009-22

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE TOWN OF SIGNAL MOUNTAIN CLEAN STREAMS TASK FORCE AS AN EIGHT (8) MEMBER SUBCOMMITTEE OF THE CITIZENS ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR THE TOWN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, the Citizens Advisory Committee was previously established in the Signal Mountain Town Code at Title 2, Chapter 2; and,

WHEREAS, there is a current need to establish a Clean Streams Task Force as a subcommittee of the Citizens Advisory Committee to the Town Council in response to current levels of E.coli contamination in three streams within the Town of Signal Mountain; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that the Clean Streams Task Force will consist of eight members; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Council recognizes that the purpose of the Clean Streams Task Force is to study and advise the Town Council on potential action steps for regulations within the Town that shall include, but not be limited to: (1) prioritizing and exploring funding options for connecting homes to sewer lines in the watersheds of Signal Mountain's impaired streams, (2) reviewing the need for septic system maintenance regulations and/or a more aggressive education program within the Town, and (3) identifying areas outside these watersheds in need of sewer connection.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council Members of the Town of Signal Mountain, Tennessee, hereby establish the Clean Streams Task Force as an eight (8) member subcommittee of the Citizens Advisory Committee for the Town Council.
