A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE SIGNAL MOUNTAIN
PLAYHOUSE AS AN OUTSTANDING COMMUNITY ASSET AND
COMMENDING IT FOR FORTY YEARS OF ENTERTAINMENT.

WHEREAS, in 1972 a group of creative young people, with support from their equally creative moms and dads, joined together to form the Signal Mountain Playhouse; and,

WHEREAS, its first performance, "The Great Cross Country Race" held on the hillside behind St. Augustine's, began a tradition of annual summer productions that continues today at the corner of James Boulevard and Rolling Way; and,

WHEREAS, in the 1980's, the Signal Mountain Playhouse also added an annual winter production that is now performed at the historic Mountain Arts Community Center; and,

WHEREAS, over the last 40 years, members of the Signal Mountain Playhouse have not only performed as actors and musicians; they have collaborated to choose plays with parts for all ages; they have worked together to design and construct costumes, scenery, props, lighting, audio systems, and special effects; they have advertised, printed playbills, sold tickets; and, they have inspired, entertained and delighted men, women, and children alike through quality community productions such as this year's "Beauty and the Beast," which was attended by over 3,000 playgoers;


