

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-46

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE HAMILTON COUNTY  
NATURAL HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN AND SUBMITTING SUCH  
PLAN TO THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY FOR  
ANY POTENTIAL DISASTERS AFFECTING THE TOWN.

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has established rules and regulations under 44 CFR Parts 201.6, which requires that “For disasters declared after November 1, 2004, a local government must have a mitigation plan approved pursuant to this section in order to receive HMGP project grants.”; and

WHEREAS, in addition, it is understood that: “For multi-jurisdictional plans, there must be identifiable action items specific to the jurisdiction requesting FEMA approval or credit of the plan”; and

WHEREAS, the FEMA regulation 201.6 requires: “Documentation that the plan has been formally adopted by the governing body of the jurisdiction requesting approval of the plan (e.g., City Council, County Commission). For multi-jurisdictional plans, each jurisdiction requesting approval of the plan must document that it has been formally adopted”; and


WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Signal Mountain, Tennessee has reviewed the draft “Hamilton County Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan”; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SIGNAL MOUNTAIN, TENNESSEE, that the Town Manager, in connection with the Hamilton County Office of Emergency Services, shall prepare and submit to the Federal Emergency Management Agency in accordance with the draft rules and regulations published by FEMA, its agreement to comply with all matters contained in the Hamilton County Natural

Hazards Mitigation Plan; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE Town Recorder be and hereby is authorized and directed to certify copies of this resolution and forward them to the Hamilton County Office of Emergency Services.
