A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING AND COMMENDING THE
SIGNAL MOUNTAIN MUSIC FESTIVAL FOR ITS
CONTRIBUTION TO THE QUALITY OF MUSIC EDUCATION
AT THE MOUNTAIN ARTS COMMUNITY CENTER.

WHEREAS, in 2010 a need was identified to create a summer event to offer area music students an opportunity to broaden their experience through an intense week of learning, playing, performing and fun; and,

WHEREAS, Barb Storm, Director of the Mountain Arts Community Center, created an event to fill that need by organizing the first "MACC String Camp" under the leadership of Maestro Robert Bernhart, to be followed the next year by Maestro Joseph Lee; and,

WHEREAS, this year, the "MACC String Camp" changed its name to the "Signal Mountain Music Festival" to encompass not only its success, but its appeal not just locally, but to the wider area of the southeast by attracting students from Georgia, Alabama and as far away as Costa Rica to learn and enjoy its increased instructional components, which now include master classes, conducting and composition classes, ensemble coaching, composition premiers and performances; and,

WHEREAS, the "Music Festival" receives strong support from the Chattanooga Symphony and Opera Youth Orchestra Board and all of the Orchestra Directors and contributes to the culture and the quality of life in our community;
