

Recycling at the Signal Mountain Recycle Center is easier than ever. Most items no longer need to be sorted and can all be deposited together in the single-stream containers marked "In Use". When they are full, attendants will open others. Please rinse all food from containers before recycling. You may leave caps/lids on all single-stream items.

Single-Stream Recycling includes the following items:

- Plastic #'s 1 – 5, & 7 (NO STYROFOAM OR PLASTIC BAGS)
- Steel and aluminum (cans, pie trays, foil, etc.)
- Newspaper and mixed paper

Glass is collected in a separate container. Please rinse all food from glass containers before recycling, remove caps/lids on all glass containers, and place only the glass in the container.

Cardboard will be compacted as usual. Because of the high volume received, the Town will continue to compact corrugated cardboard. Please remember to remove all packing material, plastic, and styrofoam from cardboard boxes before placing them into the machine. Note: Only attendants may operate the machine.

Please dispose of styrofoam elsewhere as the Center cannot handle it at this time.

Electronics:

- Computers (desktops & laptops)
- Monitors & printers
- TVs (flat screen only, no CRT/Tubes)
- Stereo equipment
- Cell phones
- Digital cameras
- VHS & DVD players

The following drop-options are for non-commercial householders only:

Hazardous Materials:

- Adhesives
- Pesticides & insecticides
- Wood preservatives
- Drain openers
- Herbicides
- Household cleaners
- Fire extinguishers
- Fluorescent bulbs (cfl & 4-foot bulbs)
- Non-latex paint & spray paint
- Brake fluid
- Fertilizers
- PP thinner
- Solvents
- Oven cleaners
- Propane tanks

Antifreeze, oil, car batteries, appliances, and scrap metal will be accepted at the Transfer Station at 714 Mississippi Avenue.
