

AN ORDINANCE ADDING TITLE SIXTEEN (16) CHAPTER ONE (1) OF THE  
SIGNAL MOUNTAIN TOWN CODE, TO INCLUDE  
NEW SECTION 16-112.

---

WHEREAS, the Town of Signal Mountain encourages citizens to utilize town sidewalks for exercise and as an alternative means of transportation for the health and wellbeing of the community; and,

WHEREAS, there are lined and marked pedestrian crossings on town streets that are used by pedestrians; and,

WHEREAS, the Town of Signal Mountain is concerned for the safety of pedestrians who may be crossing town streets in these specially marked pedestrian crossing areas;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SIGNAL MOUNTAIN, TENNESSEE, THAT Title Sixteen (16), Chapter One (1) of the Signal Mountain Town Code is hereby amended to add new Sections 16-112.

SECTION 1. This new Section 16-112 shall include the following language:

16-112. Pedestrian Crossings. Pedestrians have the right of way at marked crossings. It shall be unlawful for any driver to fail to bring their vehicle to a complete stop at marked pedestrian street crossings when pedestrians are in the marked crossing areas or are waiting to use the marked crossing areas.

SECTION 2. This ordinance amendment shall become operative from and after its date of final passage, the public welfare requiring it.
