A RESOLUTION HONORING THE MEMORY OF DR. PAUL NOLAN AND
RECOGNIZING HIS MANY YEARS OF SERVICE TO THE TOWN OF
SIGNAL MOUNTAIN

WHEREAS, Dr. Paul Nolan was born and reared in western North Carolina and graduated from Mars Hill Junior College, the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill and the University of Maryland where he received a degree in medicine; and,

WHEREAS, Dr. Nolan served his country in the U.S. Navy during WWII and the U.S. Air Force during the Korean Conflict; and,

WHEREAS, Dr. Nolan and his wife Anne moved to Signal Mountain in 1959 when he became Medical Director for E.I. DuPont in Chattanooga; and,

WHEREAS, Dr. Nolan later served twelve years on the Hamilton County Quarterly Court, a term in the Tennessee Legislature, and sixteen years on the Hamilton County Commission for the citizens of this community; and,

WHEREAS, Dr. Nolan also served as a Life Deacon at the Signal Mountain Baptist Church and as a member of the Signal Mountain Library Board from 1998-2004; and,

WHEREAS, Dr. Nolan was always a champion of education and worked to secure the location and property for a new elementary school for Signal Mountain, which opened in 1998 and currently bears his name; and,

WHEREAS, Dr. Nolan is remembered in this community as the husband of Anne Nolan and as the father of three children, Thomas Nolan, John Nolan, and the late Lou Anne Nolan Harrelson, and he and Anne have five grandchildren, and two great-grandchildren;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SIGNAL MOUNTAIN TENNESSEE, that the memory of Dr. Paul Nolan and his many years of outstanding and dedicated service to this community is hereby honored.
