
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH A.D. ENGINEERING SERVICES, INC., FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES ASSOCIATED WITH PRELIMINARY DESIGN AND ESTABLISHING CONSTRUCTION COST ESTIMATES FOR THE RENOVATION AND IMPROVEMENT PROJECT FOR MARION AND DRIVER FIELDS AND ACCESSORY STRUCTURES, FOR THE AMOUNT OF NINE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$9,450.00) AND, SUBJECT TO PROJECT APPROVAL AND FUNDING, PROFESSIONAL SERVICES ASSOCIATED WITH DESIGN, BIDDING AND CONSTRUCTION PHASE SERVICES FOR THE PROJECT FOR THE AMOUNT OF FIFTY SEVEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$57,500.00) RESULTING IN A TOTAL NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF SIXTY SIX THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$66,950.00)

WHEREAS, the Town of Signal Mountain desires to apply for a Local Parks and Recreations Fund grant to renovate and improve Marion and Driver Fields and associated accessory structures; and

WHEREAS, the application process will require a preliminary design and cost estimates for the project; and

WHEREAS, subject to funding and approval of the project, additional professional services associated with the design, bidding and construction phases of the project will be required.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SIGNAL MOUNTAIN, TENNESSEE, that the Town Manager is authorized to enter into a professional services agreement with A.D. Engineering Services., Inc., for professional services associated with preliminary design and establishing construction cost estimates for the renovation and improvement project for Marion and Driver fields and accessory structures, for the amount of NINE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$9,450.00) and, subject to project approval and funding, professional services associated with design, bidding and construction phase services for the entire construction project for the amount of FIFTY SEVEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$57,500.00) resulting in a total not to exceed amount of SIXTY SIX THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$66,950.00).
